A thermal printer is a printer that uses heat to print an image on paper. These printers are used by many businesses nowadays for printing receipts in banking and retail shops. Not only are they more efficient than impact (dot-matrix) printers, but thermal printers are proving to be more cost effective and reliable. There are many advantages to using a thermal printer which include:

- Reduced Printing Costs** - Thermal printers do not use ink, which means that there will be no need to replace ribbons.
- Increased Printing Speed** - Thermal printers are able to print much faster than other printers. Their printing heads create images in milliseconds, resulting in much faster lines per second and less time waiting on the print to complete.
- Friendlier to the Environment** - These narrower (80mm) receipts use much less paper than the typical 8½ inch wide receipt. Save the trees!
- Reduced Maintenance costs** - Because these printers contain less moving parts it makes them more reliable and durable since there are fewer things that can go wrong.
- Smaller physical dimensions** - Thermal printers can be less than 1/3 the size of a traditional impact (dot-matrix) printer which gives more flexibility in placement.



Our Emortelle application is currently compatible with narrow receipt printers and has formats for narrow receipt printing.
