This facility allows a member from a Credit Union to perform Enquiry, Deposit and Withdrawals transactions at another participating Credit Union in real time.


The Shared Services module is an authorizing and transaction processing module designed to respond to requests from other Credit Unions conforming to the ISO8583 financial messaging standard.


